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NO SURPRISE ACT

The No Surprise Act protects uninsured, “self-pay” families from any unexpected high medical bills.

Under this act, there are new billing protections when receiving emergency/non-emergency care from out of network providers at in-network facilities and ambulance services.

Families are eligible to receive a “**Good Faith Estimate**” of what they may be charged **BEFORE** they receive their care.

NOTE:

Families could be charged more than the estimate if additional items/services are required at the time of service that your provider may not have anticipated.
